
Although every effort is made to stock our wines on the list, sometimes availability from the estate can lead to products being out of stock or vintages being different to those specified.

### Exchange policy



1. We do not allow tastings on our wines as all stock is portion controlled.

## CHAMPAGNE

### **Bollinger R.D. Extra Brut 1988 (Champagne)**

**R6000**

A Classic legendary 1988 vintage for the connoisseur

### **Bollinger La Grande Année Brut 1999 (Champagne)**

**R4500**

This is a phenomenal Champagne with intense aromas of crème brûlée, dried apple, dried apricot and pear. Some tropical fruit but always subtle. Full-bodied dense and layered with beautiful fruits and a long, long finish. Wonderful fruit, limestone and white pepper aftertaste.

### **Moët & Chandon Brut (Champagne) NV**

**R1050**

Created in 1869, it embodies Moët & Chandon's unique style, a style distinguished by its bright fruitiness, its seductive palate and its elegant maturity

### **Moët & Chandon Brut Rosé (Champagne) NV**

A spontaneous radiant, romantic expression of the Moët & Chandon style, a lively, intense bouquet of red fruits (wild strawberry, raspberry & cherry)

### **Pearly Bay Pink Rosé (Paarl) NV**

**Bottle R85**

**Glass R22**

This sparkling rosé wine has delicious red berry and peach aromas and flavours and a sweet, soft finish.

### **Pierre Jourdan Brut Piccolo MCC (Franschoek) NV**

**R110 375ml**

A brilliantly balanced brut that has lively lime notes and a soft, lingering finish driven by Chardonnay.

### **KWV Cuvee Brut (Paarl) NV**

**R140**

Crisp and fresh with a lingering aftertaste

### **Durbanville Hills Sparkling Sauvignon Blanc (Durbanville) NV**

**R145**

The burst of tiny bubbles on the tongue awakens the palate, allowing it to fully appreciate the fresh fruit flavours of the wine. Invigorating and refreshing.

### **Graham Beck Demi Sec (Robertson) NV**

**R270**

For those who do not like it dry, the Graham Beck Demi-Sec is a fine excuse for self-indulgence and frivolity. Light yeasty aromas, with hints of butterscotch, honey and praline; this delectable bubbly will stimulate your sweeter senses.

### **Pongraz Rosé (Stellenbosch) NV**

**R290**

Delicate yeasty tones are layered with whiffs of baked bread and ripe berry fruit on the nose. On the palate it is perfectly balanced with clean acidity and juicy blackberry fruit.

### **Graham Beck Blanc de Blanc 2013/2014 (Robertson)**

**R460**

Rich aromas of fresh lime and ripe apricot fruit on the nose. An exciting fine mousse with an explosion of tangerines on the palate. Great brioche and yeast complexity broaden the palate, leading to a long, elegant finish.

### **Graham Beck Brut Rosé 2013/2014 (Robertson)**

**R460**

This bubbly has a beautiful salmon pink hue. Noticeable ripe blueberries and a subtle spiciness from the Pinot Noir with creamy complexity from the Chardonnay. An explosion of raspberry fruit and slight honeysuckle flavours on the palate, with a persistent yet delicate mousse.

### **Pongraz Brut (Stellenbosch) NV**

**R500 1.5L**

Pongrácz Brut, a Cap Classique as elegant as it is stylish, is composed of two noble varieties, Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. This dry Cap Classique has a wonderful foaming mousse and persistent bead with a classic yeast and biscuit character that culminates in a full, fruity finish. Its crisp green apple tones and baked bread nuttiness set it apart from other Méthode Cap Classiques.

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

**Laborie 2017 / 2018 (Western Cape)**

**Bottle R125**

**Glass R32**

This layered Sauvignon Blanc shows prominent aromas of orange blossom, cut grass and tropical fruit, with hints of lime and minerality. The fresh and zesty palate is well balanced with a linear acidity and fruity finish.

**Hoopenburg 2017 / 2018 (Stellenbosch)**

**R145**

Fresh from the vine with plenty green fig and gooseberry flavours. This wine is loaded with texture and depth on the palate.

**Linton Park 2017 / 2018 (Wellington)**

**R190**

This wine is a sheer delight from the enticing body colour through to the tropical fruit and light floral aromatics which move from the glass to nose. A long aftertaste with a delightful line of natural acidity is enjoyed on the medium bodied mouth-feel. Nothing cloying nor heavy as the wine is fresh and lively, glass after glass.

**Hermanuspietersfontein No. 5 2015 /2016 (Sondagkloof)**

**R220**

A wood matured Sauvignon blanc with a splash of Semillon offers a well developed structure and textured complexity. The 2015 vintage is also a Platter Five star.

**KWV Mentors 2014 / 2015 (Elim)**

**R270**

This serious Sauvignon Blanc wine shows upfront gooseberry, asparagus and floral aromas on the nose. The palate is complex, austere and textured with hints of canned peas and dill. The linear acidity contributes to the complexity of the wine and ensure a zesty finish.



# CHENIN BLANC

**Laborie 2016 / 2017 (Western Cape)**

**Bottle R125  
Glass R32**

This lively and fresh Chenin Blanc shows prominent aromas of pineapple, tropical fruit and litchi with underlying hints of oak and almonds. On the palate, the wine is concentrated and round with nuances of kumquat and guava. Its linear acidity enhances the wine's freshness and enduring finish.

**Rietvallei 2017 / 2018 (Robertson)**

**R145**

This is a dry but fruity Chenin Blanc with intense aromas of dried apple, fresh citrus and a touch of oak spice. The palate is rich and creamy with a firm but balanced acidity, complemented with a lingering aftertaste that seem to last forever.

Bright green apple and melon flavours, unfolding into layers of citrus and mineral notes, finishing crisp and clean.



# CHARDONNAY

Glass R32**

Radiant pale gold with a youthful green glow. Attractive pineapple and lemon & lime fruit purity with an intensity on both the nose and palate. A gracious and engaging wine even without oak.

**Boschendal 1685 2017 /2018 (Stellenbosch)**

**R210**

On the nose an abundance of tropical fruit flavours with hints of lime and green fig. A melange of yellow and green tropical fruits with hints of citrus. A soft, full-bodied wine with a harmonious palate and coated acidity adding to the zesty, mineral finish. Good balance between acidity and structure, with a persistent lingering length.

**Plaisir de Merle 2017 / 2018 (Paarl)**

**R265**

Round and full with stone fruit, citrus and sweet, ripe tropical flavours and a light toastiness layered with creaminess in a lingering aftertaste. Sweet vanilla oak flavours enrich the taste experience.

**La Couronne 2015 / 2016 (Franschoek)**

**R285**

Our barrel fermented Chardonnay is a vibrant and complex wine with a mouth feel and firmer structure. It has the ability to stay fresh for many years in the bottle.

## THE STORY OF PINOTAGE

The incredible series of coincidences behind the foundation of the Pinotage wine are now well known around the globe. After brushing a male Hermitage (Cinsaut) flower against a pollen donor Pinot Noir in 1925, Abraham Izak Perold created four seeds that he planted in his own garden.

The generally accepted theory about this surprisingly mismatched blend of parent grapes is that Perold was trying to create a baby with the best characteristics of mum and dad – the classic Pinot taste of burgundy with the easy-to-grow disease-resistant quality of Cinsaut.

After the experiment, Perold seemingly forgot about it and left for university, leaving his garden to overgrow. A young lecturer who knew about the four seedlings happened to cycle past the residence as a clean-up team entered the garden – he was just in time to save the seedlings.

These were re-established in the nursery at Elsenburg Agricultural College by Perold's successor, CJ Theron. In 1935 he grafted material from the seedlings on newly established Richter 99 and Richter 57 rootstock at Welgevallen. The farm Myrtle Grove near Sir Lowry's Pass will go down in history as the place where the first commercial planting of Pinotage was made.

The grapes ripened early, high sugar levels were achieved easily and the vines stayed healthy and vigorous. The early wines also showed a deeper, more intense ruby colour than either parent did. The first real recognition came in 1959 when a Bellevue red wine made from Pinotage was designated the champion wine at the Cape Wine Show.

Much of the harvest was used to bulk out popular blends, or for cheap jug wines, or was even distilled for brandy. It seemed as if the final nail had been hammered in Pinotage's coffin during a visit to South Africa by a group of British Wine Masters in 1976.

They did not like this new varietal at all. They described the nose as 'hot and horrible', and said the wine reminded them of acetone.

The flavour didn't fare much better. 'Rusty nails' was one of the more polite phrases used. Many producers then decided Pinotage had no future, and uprooted large areas of well-established Pinotage vines.

A few producers kept the faith. They continued to look for ways to improve the quality of the grape. More particularly, they concentrated their efforts in the cellar. The Diner's Club Winemaker of the Year focuses on a specific varietal or wine category.

The 1987 competition was dedicated to Pinotage. The winning wine was made by Beyer's Truter at Kanonkop. Wine lovers went back to their cellars and opened the old bottles of Pinotage that they had stored right at the back. They were very pleasantly surprised at how well the wine had aged.

Pleasant berry, banana and chocolate flavours had developed. Four years later, the same winemaker put South African Pinotage on the world wine map once again. Kanonkop's Beyers Truter was named International Winemaker of the Year at the 1991 International Wine and Spirit Competition.

He was the first South African winemaker ever to win this prestigious competition. Another delegation of British Wine Masters visited the country in the early 90s.

This time they sang Pinotage's praises. No more 'hot and horrible', or 'rusty nails'. This time they used phrases like 'excellent wine and grape variety with tremendous potential', and the 'future of South Africa', and 'Pinotage should be taken seriously'. In 1995, James Suckling, the editor of American Spectator, visited the Cape for a tasting of old Kanonkop Pinotages. He declared "What the hell is going on here? These are spectacular, spectacular!"

At last, after seventy years, South Africa's home-hero wine was receiving the kind of acclaim for which it had been waiting for.. PINOTAGE"

**Durvanville Hills 2017 / 2018 (Durbanville)**

**Bottle R150**

**Glass R38**

Full character wine. A rich fruity character fills the mouth, backed by silky tannins and raspberry and red cherry flavours

**Nederburg Reserve 2016 / 2017 (Paarl)**

**R185**

Ruby red in colour. A bounty of plums and prunes and subtle oak spices. A full mouthfeel with rich fruit flavours, soft tannins and a lingering aftertaste.

**Doolhof Dark Lady 2017 / 2018 (Limietberg)**

**R195**

A coffee, mocha explosion with dark chocolate, rich black fruit, almonds and black cherries on the nose. Light to medium body with firm, well integrated tannins.


**KWV Mentors 2014 / 2015 (Costal Region)**

**R400**

This wine reflects the true varietal characteristics of a modern-styled Pinotage, with an abundance of cranberries, blackcurrent, plums and hints of fruit cake and vanilla on the nose. The intense concentration of the palate shows sweet fruit and well-integrated oak. The silk-smooth tannins contribute to the wine's juicy, round and seamless finish.

## SHIRAZ

**Laborie 2016 / 2017 (Western Cape)**

**Bottle R160  
Glass R40**

This luxurious deep purple Shiraz has prominent aromas of ripe plum, blackcurrent and dried spice with hints of aniseed and cloves. The palate benefited from judicious oaking, which delivered a full juicy tannin structure and good length.

**Lands End 2015 / 2016 (Elim)**

**R175**

Rich aromas of black cherry, sandalwood, truffle and black pepper with a hint of roast beetroot. A soft velvety palate with silky texture and fine tannins, plum and cherry fruit and a long savoury finish.

**Waverley Hills 2013 / 2014 (Wolsley)**

**R190**



Sweet plum, fynbos and rosemary with white pepper.

**BENGUELA COVE 2015 / 2016 (Hermanus)**

**R300**

A lush, sweet palate is given definition with delicate spice and cherry flavours. Finely integrated tannins and a style reminiscent of the Northern Rhone shows the promise of great longevity.

## MERLOT

**Laborie 2016 / 2017 (Western Cape)**

This elegant Merlot shows aromas of black cherries, plums and dried herbs, with a nuance of cigar box. The palate is vibrant and well-rounded with silky tannins and a fragrant elegant finish.

**Nederburg Reserve 2016 / 2017 (Paarl)**

**R185**

Dark ruby in colour with aromas of strawberries, blackcurrants and subtle vanilla oak. A Medium-bodied wine with attractive up-front fruit flavours and a soft, silky texture.

**Boschkloof 2016 / 2017 (Stellenbosch)**

**R275**

Deep, ruby red colour. A very attractive, complex nose with aromas of spice, forest floor, cherry and wild berries. The palate has lovely velvety berry fruit with firm but fine tannins. Good structure and balance with a long finish. The wine is accessible upon release but will benefit from 6-8years ageing.

**Plaisir de Merle 2016 / 2017 (Paarl)**

**R420**

On the taste it is well structured with a pleasant soft and velvety palate, layers of ripe sweet red berries and prunes and supported by cedar and vanilla oak flavours. It has a rich lingering aftertaste.

## History of Pinot Noir

Originating in the Burgundy region of France, Pinot Noir wine is considered by some to be the best red wine in the world. The origins of the vine are obscure, and while it is possible that it originates with Roman occupation of France in the 1st Century AD, it is just as likely that it represents a French domestication of a wild bush vine. Pinot Noir is one of the wines used to create traditional French champagne, but it is also a stand-alone wine which has many fans across the globe. It has been in South Africa for many years, and was one of the two vines crossed to produce Pinotage, the country's unique wine.

There is an enormous demand for Pinot Noir wine, both in the South African domestic market, and in the overseas markets. It is in some ways considered to be a very romantic and delicious wine that reduces wine experts to tears, but it is unpopular amongst growers due to its reputation as a very difficult cultivar. In fact, one grower observed that Pinot Noir was made by the Devil, and its sensitivity to wind, frost and cold make many growers agree. Despite this, wine makers tend to enjoy battling the wine, and its very sensitivity means that it picks up any differences in the soil, passing these on to the drinker.

Due to the nature of these differences, there is a great deal of variety in the tastes and aromas of different Pinot Noir wines. The average wine tends to have a medium body, with a deep aroma of fruits and currants. The freshly made wine will often be a deep orange-red, rather similar to Garnet, a distinctive colour compared to similar red wines. In South Africa, the wine tends to be rather earthy, although this can depend upon the region in which it was grown, as well as the wine-making process.

There are a number of different varieties of the Pinot Noir vine, with the Pinot Gris being perhaps the best known. This genetic mutation produces different coloured grapes, and the wine inside can be yellow, orange or even pink. Pinot Meunier is also connected to the production of champagne, and is considered to be another genetic mutant from the Pinot Noir. Most wine drinkers do not realise that these two types of wine are available, or how related they are to Pinot Noir.

There are several different wine estates now producing single-varietal Pinot Noir wines, including the Haute Cabriere, made from 100 percent Pinot Noir grapes. These grapes are crushed and then matured in oak barrels for 9 months. The 2006 version has a number of cherries, raspberry and other fruit aromas, along with plenty of tannins and a pleasing quantity of acids which just tickle the palate during the aftertaste. This wine is still comparatively young for a Pinot Noir, and drinkers can expect it to mature for another 5-7 years before it will reach the full flavour of its potential.

Here in Hermanus we have the ideal climate for Pinot Noir with the gentle sea breeze providing optimum conditions. We are responsible for producing some of the world's best Pinot Noirs. If you are a guest in our area no visit is complete without a day spent in the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley.

Upfront fruit flavours of raspberries and cranberries with earthy tones and cherry on the palate and aftertaste

**Hoopenburg**

**2016 / 2017 (Stellenbosch)**

**R200**

Upfront aromas of strawberries and raspberries, with subtle hints of flowers and spice. The palate is extremely fresh and fruity, with a very fine grained mid palate tannin.

**The Brew Cru**

**2017 / 2018 (Cape South Coast)**

**R325**

This elegant wine shows prominent aromas of wild cherries and raspberries with earthy undertones. It has a finely textured palate with silky tannin, strawberry makes way for slight savoury notes followed by a fresh and vibrant finish.

**Haute Cabriere Reserve**

**2014 / 2015 (Franschoek)**

**R420**

From a small crop, this intense grape was matured in 30% new French oak for 10 months resulting in a wonderfully integrated and perfectly balanced wine.

**Hamilton Russell Vinyards**

**2016 / 2017 (Hemel-en-Aarde)**

**R550**

Characteristic tightness and elevated length is balanced by a rich generous mineral palate with dark, spicy, complex fruit. A classic terroir driven wine and most highly rated South African Pinot noir in The Wine Spectator and Robert Parker.



## RED BLENDS & OTHER VARIETALS

**Zonneblom SMV**      **2016 / 2017 (Stellenbosch)**      **R175**

Burgundy red. Ripe, succulent dark berry fruits with hints of oak spice and a smoky finish. Full and rich with a complex mixture of dark fruit and plum flavours. Intense spice on the palate with traces of nutmeg and oak, support by firm tannins.

**Roodeberg Red**      **2016 / 2017 (Western Cape)**      **R180**

This famous red blend shows aromatic layers of cranberries, spicy dried herbs and fruit cake, with undertone of cinnamon and dark chocolate. The palate is well rounded with nuances of cedary oak on a juicy tannin structure, extending to an elegant finish.

**Linton Park Malbec**      **2017 / 2018 (Wellington)**      **R200**

Full bodied, deep purple coloured Malbec. Full of ripe, juicy berries and plum aromas on the nose follow through to a complex and deliciously layered mouth feel with well-integrated tannins.

**Rietvlei Cinsaut**      **2015 / 2016 (Robertson)**      **R220**

This uniquely dark and decadent Cinsaut truly personifies its name. Dark Cin is as enchanting as it is captivating with a touch of the mysterious... Dark plum red in colour. The nose reveals dark earthy black berry fruit with touches of spice and smokey nuances. The palate is intense with juicy berry fruit and hints of chocolate and a spicy freshness. Beautifully rounded with gentle inviting fruit tannins and a delicious, juicy, all-encompassing finish.

**Beyerskloof Synergy**      **2014 / 2015 (Stellenbosch)**      **R225**

An abundance of black fruit upon entry leads to a big, juicy middle with soft, well rounded tannins. A classic Cape Blend with a pleasant lingering aftertaste.

**Brampton Roxton**      **2017 / 2018 (Coastal Region)**      **R230**

The Petit Verdot contributes to the muscular structure of the wine while the Shiraz adds a distinctive flavour to the mid-palate. The Malbec adds bright berry fruit. This wine displays delicious dark black cherries with dark chocolate and spice on the mid-palate and a lingering finish.



**Plaisir de Merle Petit Plaisier**      **2017 / 2018 (Simodium)**      **R240**

Concentrated cherry, plum and red berry, and light savoury flavour notes.

**Doolhof Single Vinyard Cabernet Franc**      **2015 / 2016 (Limietberg)**      **R260**

Youthful, dark red with perfumed blackcurrants, violets, truffles and graphite on the nose. Great elegance and softness with fine velvety tannins.

**KWV Mentors Petit Verdot**      **2015 / 2016 (Western Cape)**      **R380**

The intense ruby red wine is concentrated and leads on the nose with sweet spiced followed by dark cherries, black olives and violets. The palate is rich and juicy with prominent fruit sweetness. The tannin structure is well integrated and delivers an intense lasting finish.

**Quest Heroes Journey 1**      **2011 / 2012 (Western Cape)**      **R400**

A classic elegance Bordeaux style of wine has a deep intense dark ruby colour. The nose shows a vibrant profusion of blackcurrent, dark chocolate and vanilla characters with a good balance of ripe fruits and soft tannins on the palate. The mouth feel is a complexity of rich floral flavours with a broad mid-palate and a long finish.

**KWV Mentors Canvas**      **2014 / 2015 (Coastal Region)**      **R400**

This multi-dimensional wine shows layered fruit flavours of plums, mulberries and black pepper. On the palate, flavours of cassis and pencil shavings combined with sweet, powdery tannins to deliver a concentrated and full-bodied wine.

**Meerlust Rubicon**      **2013 / 2014 (Stellenbosch)**      **R600**

A typical liquorice note and stony minerality also evident on the nose. The palate is full bodied, structured by beautifully sleek, ripe tannins which restrain the vibrant dark fruit.




